In just 11 weeks, Mangum Manor residents have pooled together **\$5,803.52** to pay for off-duty HPD officers to patrol our neighborhood.

That is 40% of our goal for the year!

As of March 29, 2017, we have pooled enough to pay officers through June 17. We currently have one officer patrolling during the day, and one at night. Each officer will be here one day per week. Specific days and times are chosen at random. Thank you so much to those who have contributed so far!

First 2 Esplanades on Antoine to be Leveled Temporarily

The civic club board received the following email from Mike Zientek, Senior Public Involvement Representative for **US 290 Program**:

We wanted to alert Mangum Manor residents to the fact that crews are now working in the Antoine median north of US 290, in preparation for the reconstruction of the Antoine/US 290 intersection. The median areas from US 290 to Poinciana will be removed, and temporary pavement placed in the area as crews then reconstruct northbound and southbound sides of Antoine. In 2014, Mr. Zientek was a guest speaker at a civic club meeting, and he let us know that the first 2 esplanades north and south of 290 would eventually need to be leveled. With cause for concern of losing all of the trees on the esplanades, a few Mangum Manor Civic Club members strapped on their volunteer safety vests and took a full inventory of the existing trees. They took pictures, measured the trunk circumference, and calculated an estimated height of every single tree.

After several more questions, the help of Traci Elsner with Mayor Pro Tem Cohen's office, Ms. Marilu De Le Fuente from the Parks Department, and months of communication, there is now a plan to replace 80% of the tree growth. The plan also includes an irrigation system. Thank you to the civic club volunteers and board members that documented the trees and communicated the need to replace the majority of existing plant life!
